**ELIGIBILITY: (Class of 2021)**

- 🗒️ Student must be a graduating senior at HHS in the current year.
- 🗒️ Student must be a member of the HHS PTSA by *April 23, 2021*. Membership will be verified.
- 🗒️ Student must have a 2.5 GPA.
- 🗒️ Student must have completed at least 4 hours of volunteer service to a service organization within the 2020-21 school year.
- 🗒️ Student must complete application, including essay and a description of your community service.
- 🗒️ Applications must be received on or before deadline of 3:00 pm EST on Friday, April 30, 2021.
- 🗒️ Students will be given points for each year they have been HHS PTSA Student members.
- 🗒️ Follow scholarship application turn in process.

**ESSAY:** Please respond in one page or less to the following:

“What have you done during your high school years to give back to Heritage High School and/or our local community?”

**NOTIFICATION OF AWARD:**

HHS PTSA will contact all successful applicants. The awards will be presented on Senior Night.

**PAYMENT OF AWARD:**

Payment of award will be made directly to the institution of higher learning upon verification that the student is enrolled at that institution of higher education.
